- There is a mandatory \$40 Registration Fee at the start of each Academic School Year or at time of Registration. This includes 1 BARCLAY Uniform Shirt T-Shirt, 1 free trial class of any group class (pending availability) and inclusion in any BARCLAY only events.
- Tuition may be paid in one installment or by following the BARCLAY payment plan agreement. Please request this from the front desk.
- There will be NO refunds, make-ups or rescheduled classes due to your absence or withdrawal from a class or program after enrolling for any reason. Private lessons *may only potentially be rescheduled based on instructor availability and if the cancellation occurs with more than 24 hours notice.*
- No refunds or rollover class credit is guaranteed or will be granted for any reason once you sign this registration form. *Full payment or a signed payment plan with an updated method of payment must be submitted before casting is announced for any show program.* If a child withdraws after casting, or withdraws from a class after confirming enrollment, the balance of your payment plan will be immediately charged to the card on file upon receipt of the withdrawal whether or not the attendance is reconsidered. If your method of payment is declined, this balance will remain on your BARCLAY account and must be cleared before enrolling in any other program. Class changes and swaps made after a student commits to the class may incur a \$15 fee.

I understand all payments are non-refundable and by enrolling in BARCLAY classes, I agree to abide by all its policies. I give permission to use photographs & videos of my child or me for any and all promotional purposes. I understand that in case of emergency, if I am unable to be contacted, I give permission to the BARCLAY or the or the staff of our partner theatres (any venue where BARCLAY is scheduled to rehearse or perform) to authorize any emergency action necessary. I/We as an individual or as a parent or guardian of the participants named herein, assume all risk and hazards incidental to the activities and release from responsibility and agree to indemnify and hold harmless BARCLAY PA, the Somerset Shoppes, their officers, directors, independent contractors, volunteers, on site theatre staff and all employees as well as any employees of affiliate theatres and their contractors, for any illness and injury to me or my children or family members occurring during his/her/our participation in any activities or use of any facilities at/or conducted by BARCLAY PA or its partnering theatres.

I understand that my child may not have any unapproved conflicts during rehearsals and/or performances of this program. Failure to comply may result in immediate dismissal from the cast or recasting, without refund.

I am aware that tickets for the performances are available at BARCLAYPerformingArts.com as well as multiple other public ticketing websites, dependent on the production location. I understand that **tickets** are available to the public and sold on a first come first serve basis.

I understand that BARCLAY Performing Arts has a strict Academy Dress Code and I/my child agrees to abide by it while participating in classes & events at BARCLAY.

Students agree to the BARCLAY code of conduct and agree to abide by BARCLAY polices when corresponding with other company members and/or commenting about BARCLAY events, shows, staff members and other students, whether inside or outside of the studio or on social media or technological devices. Bullying or harassment of any form will result in a dismissal from the program. Signing this document means you have read and agree to the terms listed herein.

NOTES on PROGRAMMING, SCHEDULES & JB COMPANY POLICIES at BARCLAY Performing Arts:

ALL ACADEMY DRESSCODE: Students are expected to be in dress code at all times at BARCLAY. Our dress code consists of a BARCLAY shirt, black movement pants (leggings, basketball shorts, joggers, shorts with tights, etc.), tan jazz shoes, no jewelry, hair pulled off of your face no smart watches, etc. We are a team and our uniform is important.

ATTENDANCE: Attendance is mandatory at classes and show program rehearsals. Our teachers plan valuable curriculum that build weekly. If you are going to miss a class or be late, please do let the office know as soon as possible.

DISCOUNTS AND BUNDLING:

-Each sibling that enrolls after or with the first sibling will receive \$15 off of their annual registration fee. The highest priced package will be charged in full with a 10% sibling discount applied to the total sum of any additional siblings class package. *This 10% discount will NOT apply to Private Lessons and Show Programs.*

-There is a 10% discount that will be applied to any student in 3 or more group classes. Enrollment in Show Programs DO count *towards* the 3 class count, however no discount is applied to the Show Program (or any Private Lessons, if enrolled).

***SHOW PROGRAMS have special rehearsal schedules.** If enrolling in a SHOW PROGRAM PLEASE SEE REHEARSAL SCHEDULES for your program as, OTHER REHEARSAL & PERFORMANCE DATES APPLY besides the weekly scheduled rehearsals.

****JB COMPANY represents the top level of training & performance quality in our Academy.** Students who maintain their JB Company status are able to benefit from partaking in certain other opportunities as outlined below.

SPRING 2023 JB REQUIREMENTS & other details include:

- ***SPRING 2023 JB COMPANY CLASS REQUIREMENTS:*** *To be eligible for an maintain Company status, students must maintain weekly enrollment in at least 1 Monday Dance Class, 1 Acting Technique Class/Program & either a Level 2 or 3 Musical Show Program and/or Company Traveling Troupe.*

- Company students are eligible to participate in select Company only Programs, Events & Workshops throughout the year as well as being eligible to join the Traveling Troupe or to represent BARCLAY at other off-site events and performances.

-Company members are first considered for Volunteer and/or Job opportunities at BARCLAY and with their partners. Troupe members receive volunteer and community service hours for all of their offsite events.

-Company members receive Company only Jackets and other special merchandise items throughout the year.

-JB Company Traveling Troupe will continue to add performance dates and times to the schedule throughout the year. Troupe members should be prepared to have performances added to their schedule and understand that prioritizing attendance at these events and performances is part of requirement of remaining in good standing with the JB Company Troupe.

In order to be considered for Company programs & Troupe without requiring a placement audition, students must have been in (and remained in good standing in) Company classes during the Fall 2022 Calendar year and be prepared to meet new & updated Company requirements for the 2022-2023 School Year. *If you are invited to join Company for Spring 2023, you will receive an email before going home for Holiday break.*

Students interested in being considered for and auditioning into Company & Troupe who do not receive an invitation must write an email to BARCLAY@BARCLAYPerformingArts.com that includes a filmed personal statement of interest in which Company programs they are interested in, why they are interested in joining Company classes, why they feel they

will be a valuable asset to the Company, and what they view the JB Company to represent. Based on this personal statement review, the BARCLAY Team will decide whether or not to invite you into auditions for Company programs.

Once a student is approved to enroll and/or audition for Company Classes, they must meet the enrollment requirements listed in the Company section at the top of this document as well as the requirements outlined below:

ALL COMPANY MEMBERS MUST MEET AND MAINTAIN THESE ADDITIONAL COMPANY REQUIREMENTS TO REMAIN IN GOOD STANDING:

- Students who are accepted into Company are clear for enrollment and participation in Company only classes, show programs, workshops, and on & offsite BARCLAY performance opportunities. Company students do not need to audition for admission to these programs or opportunities, they only need to audition for roles within those programs.
- Students must maintain BARCLAY standards and remain in good standing at school (academically and socially) to be a part of the JB Company.
- Students must maintain BARCLAY standards of professionalism and kindness on and off BARCLAY premises to be a part of the JB Company.
- Students who are REQUESTING to be in Company Programs will be notified as to whether or not they are invited to audition for Company programs AFTER the office receives & reviews their statement of intent.
- The JB Company shows and classes exemplify the highest level and standards of BARCLAY training, performance and discipline. Company members are expected to be walking examples of BARCLAY's methodology and its mission. Company members are BARCLAY ambassadors and are expected to maintain consistent attendance, preparation, and a positive reputation in order to maintain their Company status.
